What is a pap smear and do I need to have one?

A pap smear is a simple test to check your cervix and make sure it is healthy. A pap smear only takes a few minutes and is not painful.

Having a pap smear every 2 years is the best way to prevent cancer of the cervix, as it can show the early warning signs: A pap smear can find abnormal cells before cancer develops.

You should have a pap smear:

- ✓ If you are a woman between 18 and 70 years of age who have ever had sex (even if you have only had one partner)
- ✓ Every 2 years (or earlier if advised to do so)
- ✓ Even if you have been through menopause
- ✓ Even if you have had the HPV vaccine
